San Francisco Presbytery

Meeting attended by Scott Barlow

Presbytery met November 15, 2025, at First Presbyterian Church of Alameda.

- **Rev. Laura Cheifetz**, Transitional Executive Presbyter, reported on her work with the Cameron House Strategic Planning retreat and town hall meeting.
- **Rev. Sungwoo Sam Kim**, Transitional Associate Presbyter, shared about his transition to the Bay Area and noted that he recently preached at PCC.
- **Rev. Don** attended his final Presbytery meeting as Co-Moderator of COM and expressed gratitude to PCC for allowing him time to serve on COM over the past six years.
- **Rev. Greg Chan** will be joining the Committee on Ministry (COM).

COM Mediation Regarding MWC

Pastor Don reported to the EWC in November that the EC continues working with COM to resolve the ongoing conflict. Workshops are being planned for all commissions to study:

- The history of the PC(USA)
- Biblical interpretation and the formation of the Bible
- Relevant sections of the Book of Order

The goal is shared learning that supports reconciliation and resolution.

- M&E brought a motion to declare the EWC a **Sanctuary Worshipping Community and Accompaniment Worshipping Community**.
 - After discussion, EC voted to ask the Sanctuary Task Force to prepare a one-page description outlining what it means to be a Sanctuary Church.
 - This will be presented to Session with the hope of declaring PCC as a whole a Sanctuary Church.
- Motion approved allowing EWC members participating in protests to publicly identify themselves as part of the PCC EWC.
